## MAJOR DONATION OF 2.2 MILLION FOR LE DOMAINE FORGET DE CHARLEVOIX

**Montréal, Tuesday, February 20<sup>th</sup>, 2018** – Le Domaine Forget de Charlevoix is proud to announce that it has received an exceptional donation of \$ 2.2 million from The Azrieli Foundation, in support of its mission of excellence. This substantial donation will enable the institution to develop new arts training programs, support ongoing initiatives and ensure that the International Academy of Music and Dance remains accessible to talented musicians.

The President of the Board of Directors of Le Domaine Forget de Charlevoix, Mrs. Louise St-Pierre, states that for over 40 years, "the institution has relentlessly pursued its evolution by adapting to the needs of its community. Mrs. St-Pierre notes that the annual budget of more than \$ 3.5 million comes from 75% of autonomous revenue, donations and sponsorships. - The development of the Jardin harmonique de sculptures.
